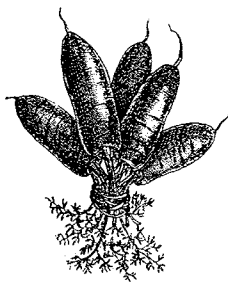
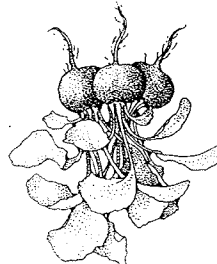
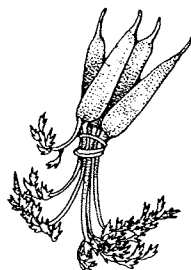

PDX Zines is a tool to find places to read, look at, buy or sell zines in Portland, Oregon. We put it together because it seemed like the list wasn't all in one place already, and because librarians believe in sharing. You are holding our eighth edition, revised and expanded.

PDX Zines was made with lots of tape, a photocopy machine, and a stapler. The cover uses Feisty McShitty and handwritten letters. Feisty McShitty is a typeface originally designed by the American graphic artist and zinester Sean Tejaratchi; this version is from a 1997 specimen sheet from *Craphound No. 5. Hearts, Hands, Eyes*. The inside text uses Aharoni and Arial Narrow, both from the computer. This edition features fruit and vegetable illustrations selected from the library's collection of clip art books.
