

	<p>OverDrive Teens: Read e-books or download digital audiobooks for kids and teens. The Libby app is available to download for mobile devices.</p>
	<p>Gale eBooks: Contains more than 9,000 full-text titles, most of them very helpful for homework assignments</p>
	<p>Hoopla: Stream movies, music, comics, TV and more. An app is available to download for mobile devices.</p>
	<p>Kanopy: Stream movies with a focus on classic, documentary, and independent films. An app is available to download for mobile devices.</p>
	<p>Digital magazines: Online copies of your favorite magazines</p>

Research Databases

	<p>African American Communities: Provides primary sources, such as newspapers, oral histories and letters, from African American communities in the US from the 1860s through the 1970s.</p>
	<p>Biography in Context: Find biographies and images for more than 525,000 people. You can search by name, country, ethnicity, job, or birth or death date.</p>
	<p>CultureGrams: Search for up-to-date facts and cultural information about countries around the world and states in the U.S.</p>
	<p>eLibrary: Search across many formats at once: magazines, newspapers, books, television and radio transcripts, maps, images, multimedia files and web resources. Created specifically for student research.</p>
	<p>Ethnic Newswatch: Discover community viewpoints from local, ethnic and minority press news sources from around the country. This is often the only online source for this content.</p>
	<p>Gale OneFile High School Edition: One stop shopping for your high school research needs. Read news articles and encyclopedia entries, listen to radio shows, and find ways to narrow your topic.</p>
	<p>ImageQuest: This resource provides images from multiple sources for your personal or educational use.</p>
	<p>Indigenous Peoples: North America: Explore the impact of invasion and colonization using primary sources such as manuscripts, newspapers, photographs, motion pictures, images of artwork and more.</p>
	<p>Learning Express: This resource includes more than 1,000 practice tests, including the GED, SAT and citizenship tests. It also includes tools to improve your job skills.</p>
	<p>Literature Criticism Online: Search for authors, poetry and literary criticism resources.</p>

	<p>Literature Resource Center: Find information on current and historical authors and their writings. Includes criticism, biographies, overviews, reviews, multimedia.</p>
	<p>Mango Languages: Learn a new language online. With more than 40 languages, including English for non-English speakers.</p>
	<p>Masterfile Premier: Read articles from thousands of popular and professional magazines.</p>
	<p>National Geographic Virtual Library: Search for articles, images, maps and advertisements found in National Geographic from 1888 to 1994.</p>
	<p>NoveList Plus: NoveList gives book recommendations for favorite authors, titles and series. Search by title, plot or writing style to find read-alikes. Find reading lists for popular genres and non-fiction, or browse reviews and discussion guides.</p>
	<p>Opposing Viewpoints in Context: Look here for issues in the news and articles from many views (pro and con) about social issues and current events.</p>
	<p>Oregon Career Information System: Learn about different jobs and the school and training they require. It includes scholarship information and demand now and in the future for each career.</p>
	<p>The Oregonian: This resource contains recent articles from <i>The Oregonian</i>, starting in 1987.</p>
	<p>The Historical Oregonian: Search and view <i>The Oregonian</i> daily newspapers from 1861 to 1987.</p>
	<p>World Book Advanced: Find articles, pictures and videos for students from the World Book Encyclopedia.</p>
