

# The Oregonian (1987-Present) Online

The Oregonian database provides indexing and full text of *The Oregonian* covering 9/1/1987 - current, updated daily. This is the place to go for local, current information or to get the local perspective on a national topic or event.

### **Getting Started**

## How do I get to the Oregonian 1987- Present?

- 1. Start at the Library Connect web site: multcolib.org/libraryconnect
- 2. Click on either middle school or high school.
- 3. Scroll down to the Resources section.
- 4. Click on The Oregonian (1987-Present).
- 5. Click on the **Begin using this resource** button.
- 6. Type in your Library Connect or library card number and password. Occasionally, there may be difficulties loading a database. If you aren't able to get in, go back and try again. If the database still doesn't open, contact the library at multcolib.org/contact.




Type your search term(s) and hit the Enter key or click on the Search button.


Note that you can type a phrase in quotation marks.

You can also search by dates, by selecting the year, month and day. Occasionally, there may be difficulties loading a database. If you aren't able to get in, go back and try again. If the database still doesn't open, contact the library's Contact Center.

• A list of articles will appear. To read an article, click on its title. The article you selected will appear on the screen.



 Note other search choices in the right sidebar, including Lexile or reading level by grade.



At the top of your search page, you can create an Alert for this search, if you
want, which will send you an alert if new articles appear in the future.



- Your search term(s) appear in bold.
- To go to the next article on the list, click on the **Next** button in the upper right corner.
- Icons at the top let you adjust text size, get the citation, email the article, print the article, download the article, save to your folder, or copy the link.


### **Image Edition**

Features full color scans of The Oregonian beginning in October of 2017. Currently no plans to add content before that date, but they will keep adding going forward.

At the top of the opening Oregonian page, click on "See Related Sources."



 You'll see a list of different options, choose the Image Edition -its format is "Image" and the date range begins in 2017. Then search by date, subject etc.
